The Background

Emotion Works was set up in March 2013 by Claire Murray, an experienced teacher and educational consultant, and creator of the Emotion Works programme. The programme promotes emotional learning and literacy in schools, early years settings and other educational services. Emotion Works provides face-to-face training, resources and practitioner support to teachers and other educators to help them deliver the programme. In addition, our website has been developed over the past few years to incorporate online training and practice support that can be accessed by members.

Emotion Works is gaining increasing interest across Scotland as a resource and movement that supports educators to address literacy and emotional wellbeing goals within the context of Curriculum for Excellence, GIRFEC and the current Attainment Challenge. Based on our recent pilots where local practitioners have set up satellite 'classrooms' offering local training and support to new recruits, we are now looking to appoint a team of educators experienced in using Emotion Works to work in a variety of geographical areas across Scotland to deliver local training and consultancy support following our satellite hub model.

The role

Each trainer-consultant will be responsible for local networking, training, capacity building, programme promotion and practitioner support. Most will be allocated to support across the Primary sector in the first instance, although Early Years, Secondary and ASL-specific roles will be considered. Much of your time will be spent visiting local schools providing information, demonstrating the resource, supporting roll out and delivering twilight training. Otherwise you can work from home or from your existing school base in agreement with your HT.

Training

- If you are not currently an accredited trainer there will be a 2-day training opportunity during the summer to help develop knowledge, understanding and skills relating to the posts. Holiday dates will be accommodated where possible

Terms & Conditions

- The posts are temporary 0.2 FTE for 26 weeks starting in August 2019 (although there is the possibility for increased hours and extension of the contract duration depending on the interest and activity generated around Emotion Works in the geographical area you are working in).
- The 7.5 hours per week can be worked as 1 full day, 2 half days or in any arrangement mutually agreed. We would expect that the working agreement would include a 1 twilight time slot per week.
- The salary will be paid monthly in arrears and will be £38,000pa on a pro-rata basis for the part time hours.
- Holidays can be accommodated within a flexible working agreement
